Gloucestershire County Association for the Blind was established in 1858 with the same aim as we have today, to help and support anyone who is blind or partially sighted in Gloucestershire.

At the moment we have over 3,000 visually impaired people on our database but it is estimated that over 5,000 people in Gloucestershire alone suffer with a sight problem.

We need to raise £150,000 a year to carry on our services. This money is raised entirely through donations as we receive no Government funding.
